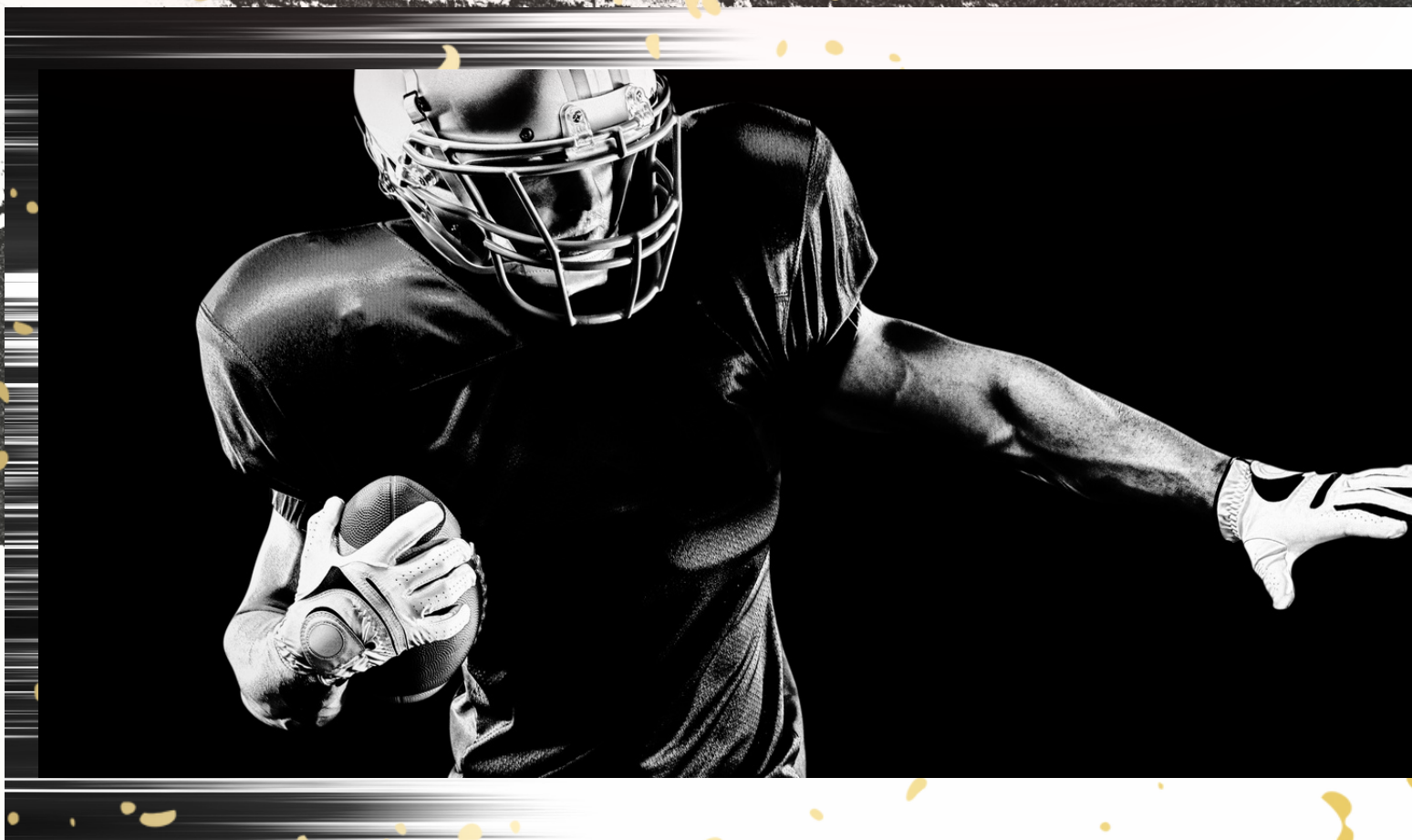

#55 Quinn Bourland

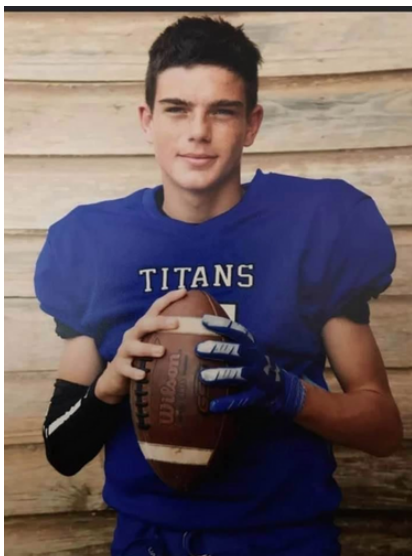
