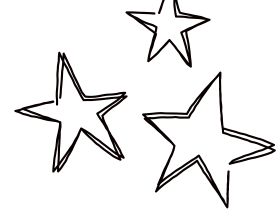

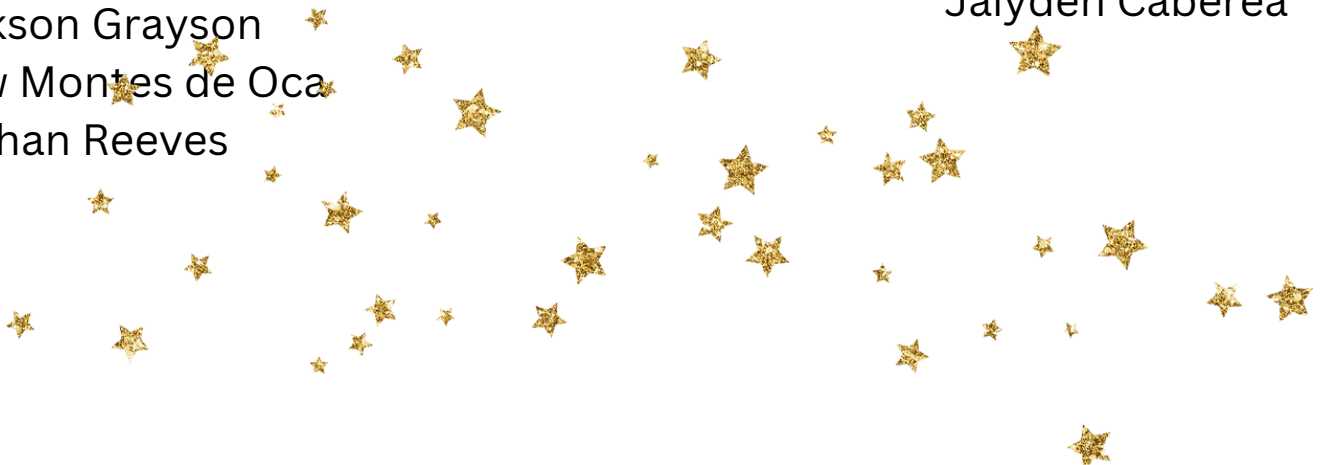

My hobbies are reading, playing games with my family, working out, and hanging out with family/friends.

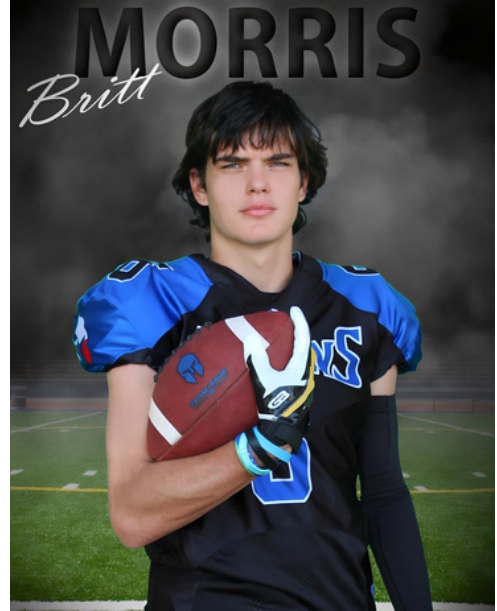
