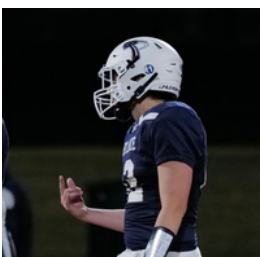
## Valor South Falcons
